



Barlow High School College & Career Center Dale Krueger Scholarship Application 2018 Information

Background: This scholarship award is \$2,000, for up to 4 years, if you maintain the required minimum college GPA and minimum 15 credit hours per college term/semester. See the scholarship website for specific guidelines. Traditionally, SBHS has been able to provide scholarships to multiple high school seniors each year. US Bank manages this scholarship according to the instructions provided by Mr. Krueger prior to his death. Complete background information regarding the scholarship can be found at the scholarship website. www.dalekruegerscholarship.com

IMPORTANT: *The 2018 the application must be submitted online.* However, you will need to have all required information and documents ready to go at the time you apply online. You will not be able to save an incomplete application on the scholarship website. *Optional* exhibit folders should be delivered to the SBHS College & Career Center, not to US Bank.

1. The scholarship winners are determined by a scholarship committee in conjunction with the GBSD Scholarship Coordinator. Applicants must apply **online with US Bank by Sunday, April 1, 2017** and may provide additional, *optional* exhibits to Sam Barlow High School's College & Career Center by **5:00pm Monday, April 2, 2018**.
2. **Complete the Dale Krueger Scholarship Worksheet** to ensure you have all required information and documents **before** going online to complete the application.
3. **Provide 7th semester transcript:** See Patty Neuenschwander, before March 24 (last day before Spring Break), to request that your transcript pdf be emailed to you – you will be responsible for attaching it to your online application. An official H.S. transcript is not required.
4. **Financial Information:** – Upload a pdf copy of your complete processed FAFSA Student Aid Report– it must include the Expected Family Contribution (EFC). The report is about 6 pages long. *All* pages of the report are required.
5. **Statement of Goals:** Submit a statement of goals summarizing the reasons for your desire to continue your education, your tentative career goals and how this scholarship will assist with your financial obligations. The Statement should be formatted at the top of the page with your name, name of scholarship and title of paper.
6. **Personal Statement:** Submit a resume' or summary of who you are, including school and community activities, sports, recognitions and accomplishments. Be sure to include the number of hours when outlining your volunteer experiences or employment history.
7. **Unusual Circumstances:** Family circumstances, illness or other barriers you have overcome will be considered in evaluating the application. If there is something you would like to make the selection committee aware of, please include this information in either the Statement of Goals or Personal Statement.
8. **Exhibit folders** must be delivered to Patty Neuenschwander, SBHS College & Career Center Coordinator, by **5:00pm on Monday, April 2, 2018**. NO EXCEPTIONS will be made. *Be sure to include letters of recommendation in this folder!*

9. Apply online at www.dalekruegerscholarship.com no later than April 1st. NO EXCEPTIONS.

- EMAIL – US bank manages this scholarship. If you win, **YOU** will be contacted by US Bank through email. Failure to respond to the Bank's email requests may result in the forfeiture of the scholarship.
- Should you change your email address, home address, or phone number it is YOUR responsibility to notify US Bank of the change. This can be easily done online at www.dalekruegerscholarship.com.
- Graduates of Barlow High School may apply for this scholarship until they reach age 21 (by the April 1 deadline.) However, these students will not receive the maximum 4-year renewable scholarship. Scholarships for college students are not guaranteed to be available every year.

- Go to: fafsa.ed.gov
- See the link on that page that says: VIEW YOUR STUDENT AID REPORT
- Log on using your user name and password.
- Open your SAR
- Go to the link that says: PRINT THIS PAGE.
- This will open the print dialogue box.
- Go to the CHANGE button
- Choose the SAVE AS PDF option.
- Save to your desktop under your name.
